# Frontier Towns

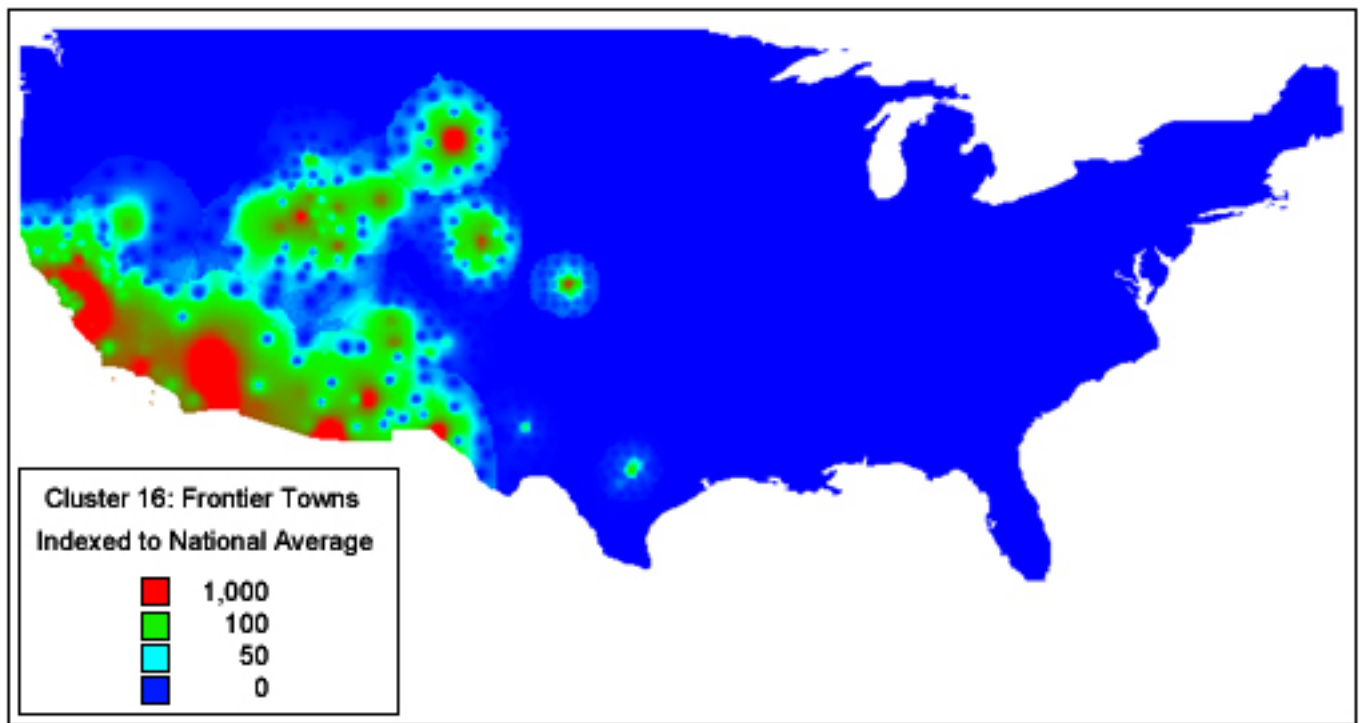

Somebody's got to mind the general store (or C-Store) or the bank or the roadside diner. In these "frontier towns" families with children have high school and community college educations. Both spouses work to earn an average of \$67,500 per year. Only 56 percent are white non-Hispanic, 31 percent are Hispanic and 15 percent are foreign born. They also work in manufacturing, holding some administrative positions. These folks are the Western gray collar workers who hold down the fort in the face of a seemingly constant onslaught of newcomers.
