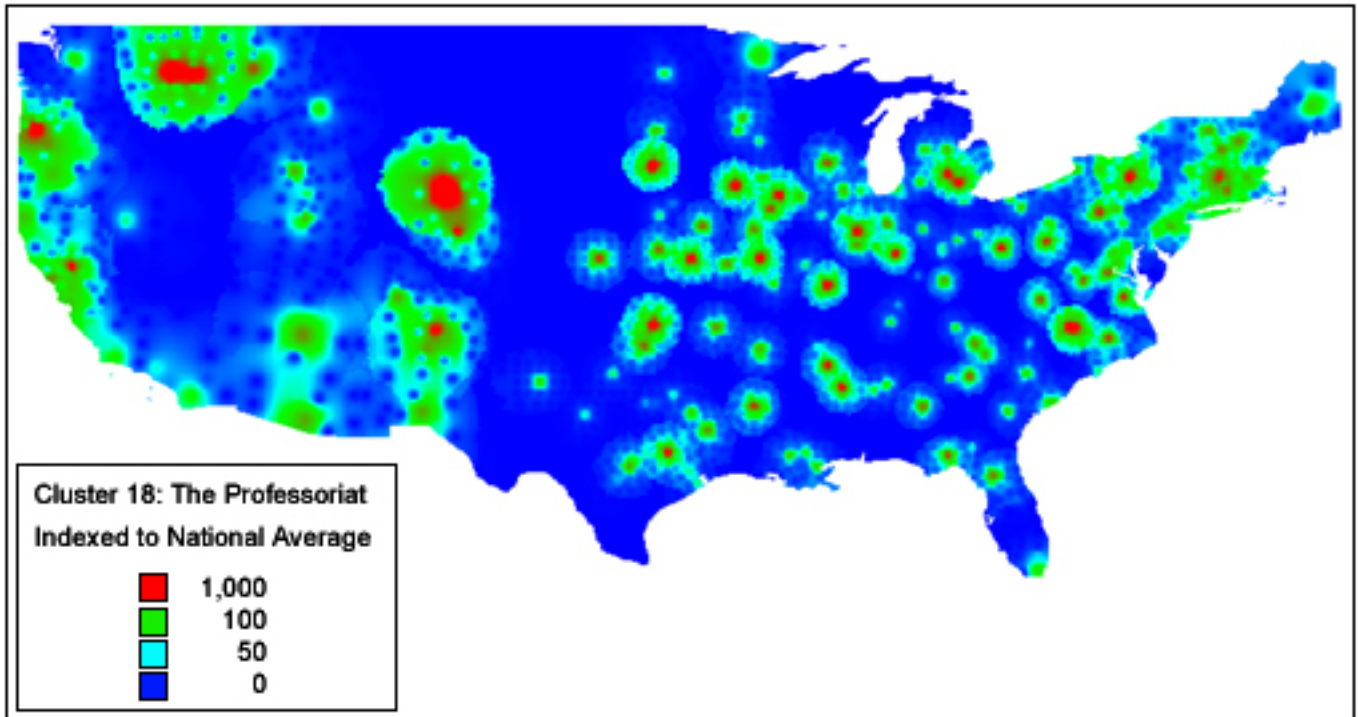
# The Professoriat
