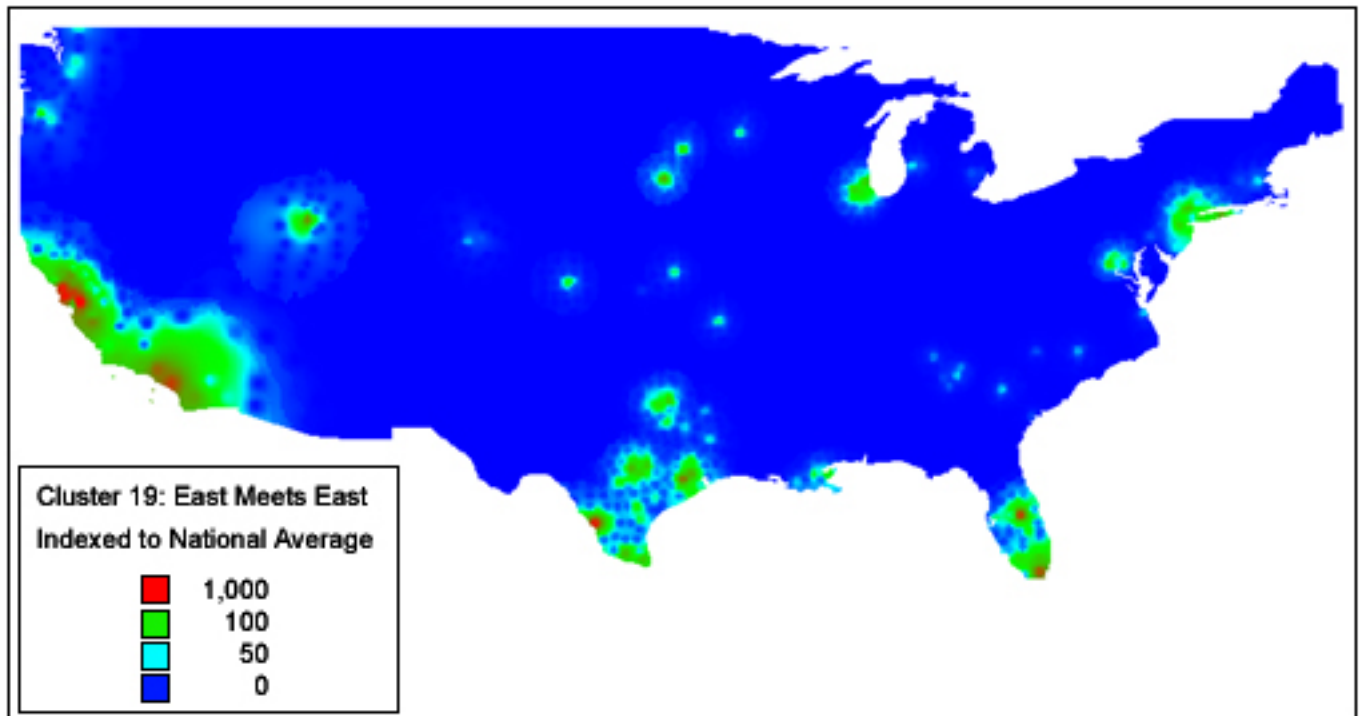

Asian immigrants often gravitate to Asian communities in the US. This means they meet other Asians as well as Hispanics (35 percent of this cluster), Blacks and other Americans. So Asian Indians, Chinese, Japanese, Vietnamese, Filipinos, and others encounter each other in America's new "salad bowl" neighborhoods. Most have families with kids and live in single detached owned homes, although 35 percent are renters. They index high on college education and have a mean family income of \$64,000. They work in a variety of industries but index highest in mathematical and computer science occupations. In today's complex urban structure, only 40 percent of workers in this cluster work in central cities.
