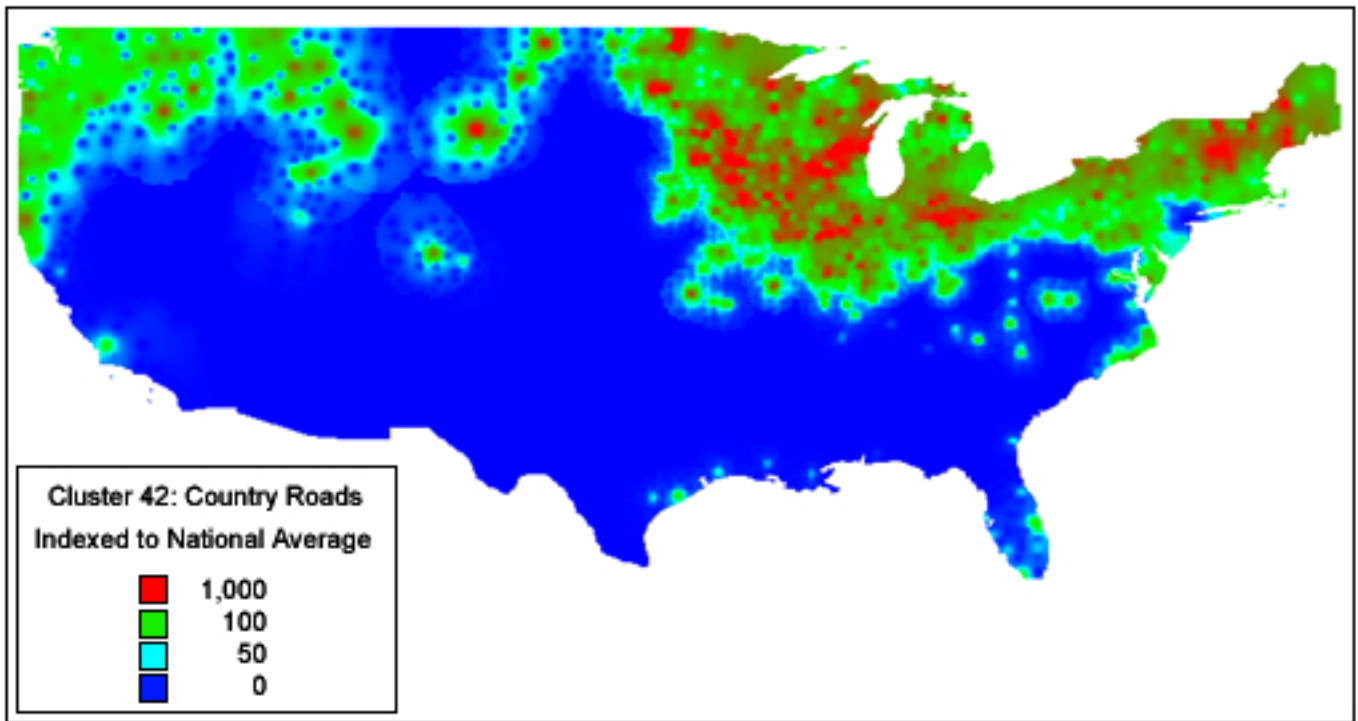
# Country Roads

With one of the highest indexes for people who still live the state where they were born, this cluster has a distinctly older age skew. Down these country roads they have a 65/35 owner to renter housing ratio due in part to their high proportion retired. Fully 97 percent were born in the US and 94 percent are white, non-Hispanic. For those still working, manual work is the order of the day, although these town and country areas also offer small office and retail-related employment. Mean family income is \$53,700. Oh, and these folks are not likely to move any time soon.
