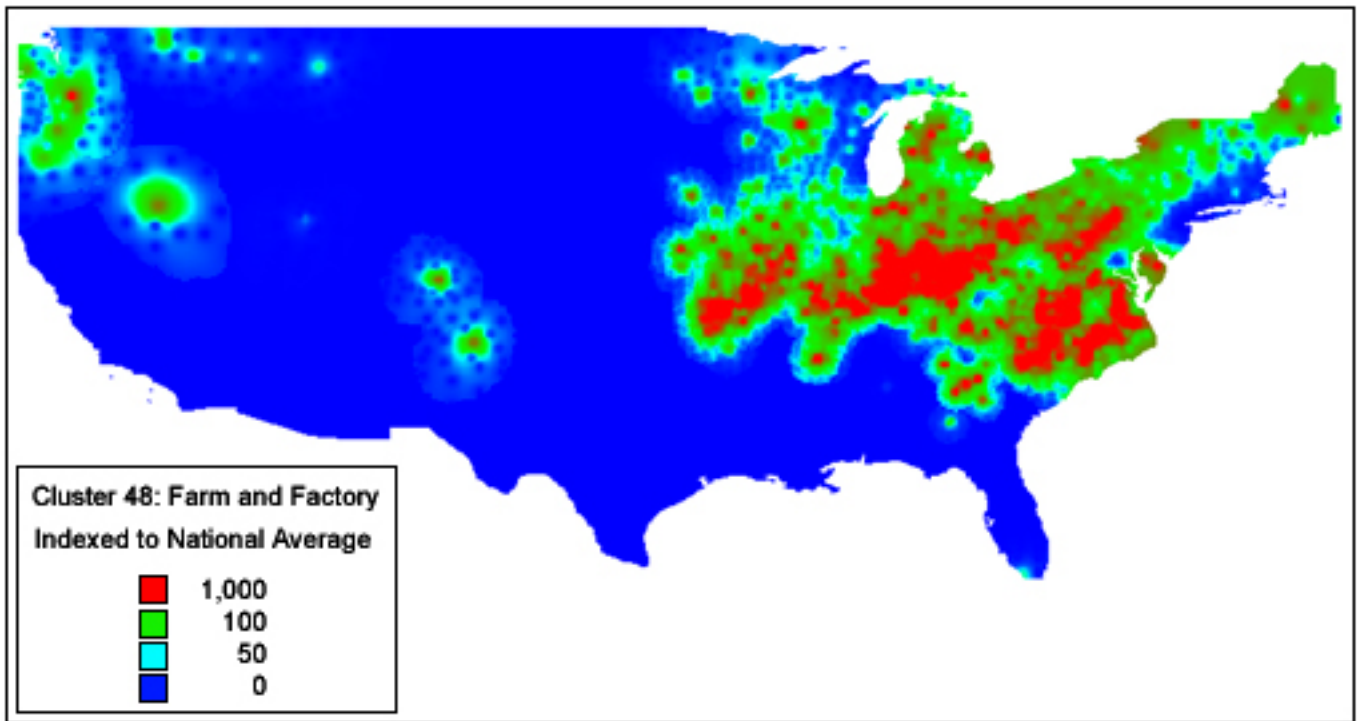

With high school educations with some college, these family householders have a wide age range -- 25 to 74. The 92 percent white, non-Hispanic reflects minimal immigration -- 98 percent were born in the USA. Mean family income is \$48,000.
