# Irrigation Nation

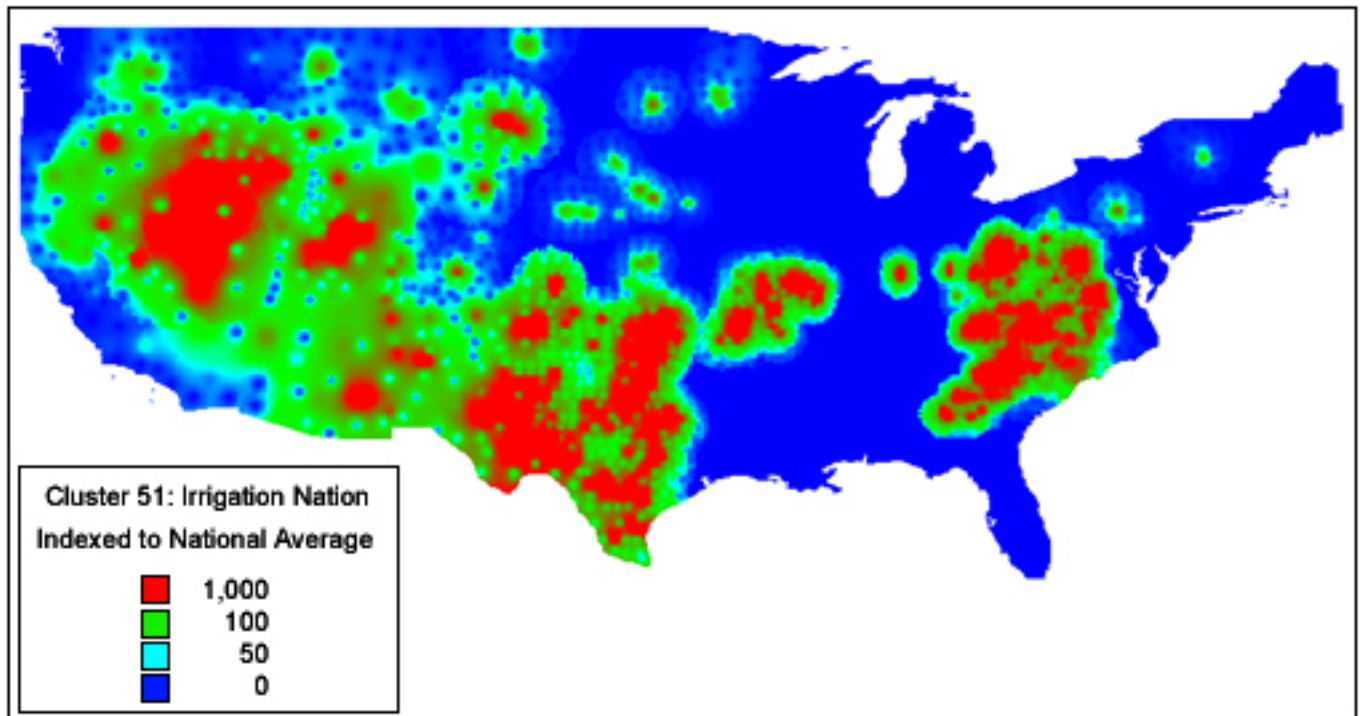

Rain for rent, migrant labor for hire – America's agribusiness communities are social systems unto themselves. Over 30 percent live in mobile homes with a 75/25 owner to renter ratio. Within the cluster some relatively new homes dot the landscape due to the Western geographic skew. Virginia and the Carolinas typify large scale farming in the East. Irrigation Nation in the West has 15 percent Hispanic population, while Irrigation Nation in the East has 15 percent African American population. Overall average family income is \$48,000.
