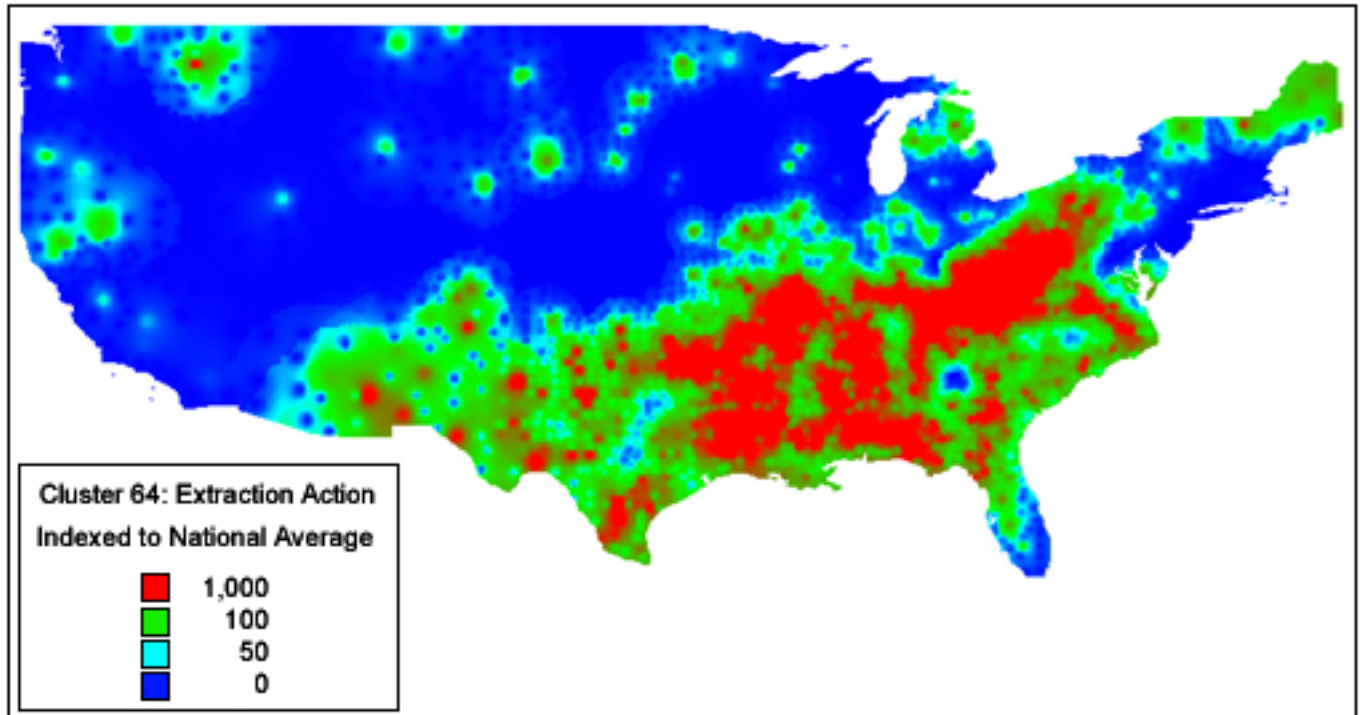

A mix of families and non-families primarily involved in extraction industries, this cluster indexes highest for coal and other mining towns. Forestry and some farming are also common. With a 67/33 owner to renter housing ratio and a high propensity (80 percent) to live in their state of birth, this cluster is 90 percent white, non-Hispanic. Their mean household income \$35,800.
