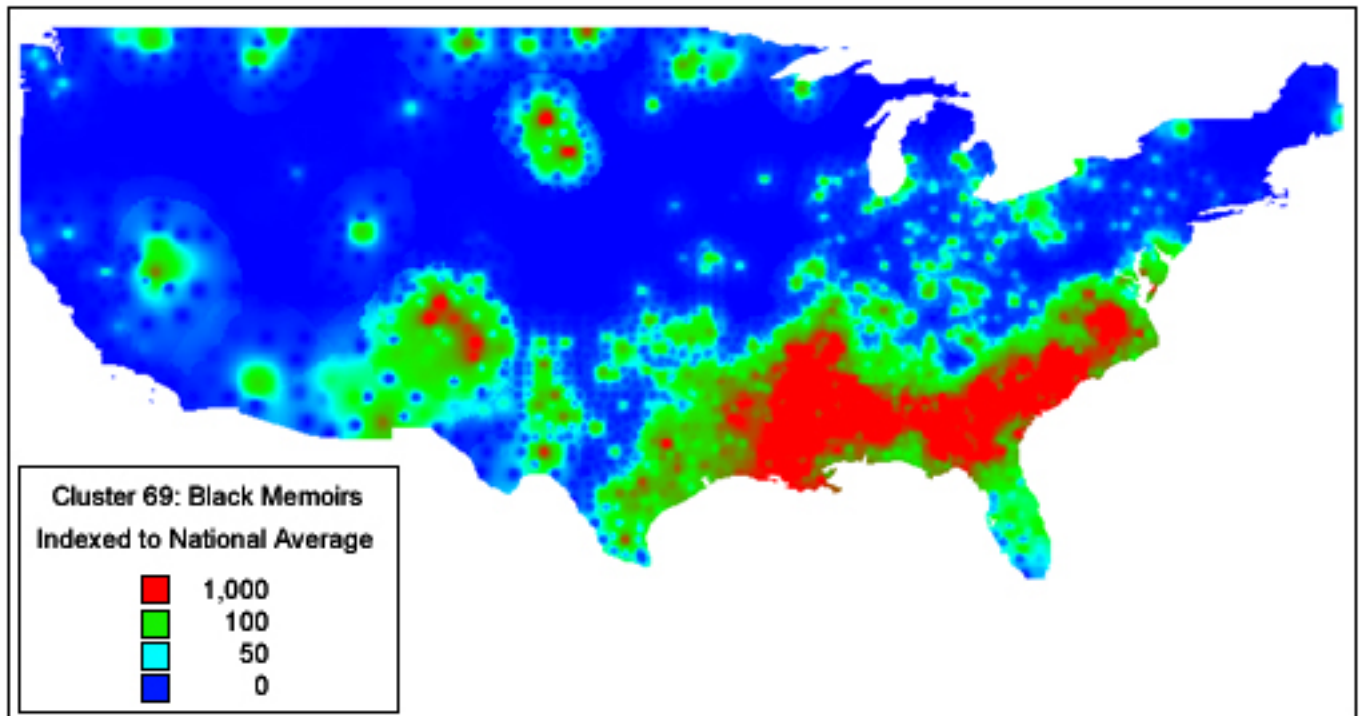

Towns and villages of the South and elsewhere with significant African American populations -- 62 percent of this cluster -- have a history and a culture not easily replicated elsewhere. Families with children abound but also older adults left behind when earlier generations left for opportunities in Northern and Southern metropolitan areas. Farm and factory workers can be found here, for example, in meat packing operations and textile mills, but also a variety of manufacturing operations. Other industries, from education to small offices also employ residents of this cluster. Average family income is \$37,000. This cluster speaks volumes.
